- Take the application form to your high school principal, headmaster or guidance counselor. That individual will complete Section II and submit the entire application with an official high school transcript to the Office of Admissions.
- GED (if applicable) from issuing source (photocopy is acceptable)
- Official SAT or ACT score (from testing center or official high school transcript)

Transfer applicants should submit,

- Completed, signed application form with \$30 processing fee.
- Official high school transcript and SATs or GED, official transcripts from each college or university attended (must be sent directly by the issuing source, i.e., Registrar to Admissions).
- RN applicants must submit official transcripts from nursing school, college or university plus photocopy of RN license
- Medical imaging applicants must submit all official transcripts plus a photocopy of license

Frequently asked questions

How soon will I hear about my completed application?

Admissions reviews your application within two to four weeks of its arrival, and notifies you by regular mail of its decision. You may also check your application status online at www.bloomu.edu/admissions

How early can I apply for admission?

You can apply at any time, but applications for the following fall begin to get consideration in late September of what would be your senior year in high school. We don't ask students to take SAT or ACT tests as juniors, but do require SAT or ACT scores for consideration of application, so it's a good idea to take them early in the senior year.

What are your application deadlines?

We admit students on a rolling admission basis, which means we review your completed application as soon as we receive it. We will notify you within two to four weeks of receiving a completed application. We encourage you to apply as early as possible. For some majors, applications received past December 1 are considered late. We also welcome applications from transfer students in good standing, as well as international and nontraditional students.

When can I come for a visit?

Group and Individual Interviews – Group presentations are held throughout each week including many Saturdays and are followed by a campus tour. Individual interviews can be made based on availability.
