

THE GAME PLAN

Form your own foursome for the scramble format, with low score on each hole recorded. Participate in the skins game for \$20 per team split 50/50 and the individual contests (longest drive, closest to pin on two holes and closest to the line) for \$5 per golfer. Betting holes: Nos. 6, 10

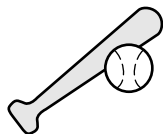


Prizes:

Rules Of The Day:

1. Register at the desk
2. Shotgun Start - Check registration form or table
3. Scramble Format
 - A. Men play from blue tee; Women play from red
 - B. Out of bounds will exist when:
 - Left of white stake on No. 3
 - Left of white stakes on No. 7
 - Right of large white post on No. 16
 - C. Free relief will be given when
 - Ball or stance is on cart
 - Stance or swing is interfered with by an immovable obstruction (man-made)
 - Ground under repair or distressed areas
 - Casual water
 - D. Red stakes - drop ball two club lengths from the point of entry - no closer to the pin with a one stroke penalty
 - E. Yellow stakes - drop ball any distance behind the hazard with a one stroke penalty
 - F. No. 10 is a continuous water hazard. The ball can be played where it lays or dropped on the tee side of the water at the drop area with a one stroke penalty
 - G. All holes must be putted out
 - H. Winter rules in effect. USGA rules otherwise govern play
 - I. In case of ties the winners will be determined by matching of cards starting at the No. 1 hole
4. Obey all course rules and please use good golf etiquette
5. Scorecards should be turned in at the end of the competition to register desk
6. Return carts to the pro shop when finished
