**MATCH UP:** Bloomsburg University opens up its 2009 season against visiting Ashland University at Redman Stadium. This will be the second straight season opener featuring these two squads, as last year's version featured a dramatic come-from-behind 49-42 victory by the Huskies. The Eagles feature 15 returning starters from a 9-4 team that finished second in the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Conference, and made the Division II playoffs for the second year in a row. The Huskies won nine straight games to open up 2008, propelling them to an 11-2 record and the program's seventh NCAA playoff appearance. Bloomsburg returns 13 starters from a team that finished near the top of the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference in both total offense and defense.

**THE HEAD COACHES:** Huskies coach **Danny Hale** (West Chester '68) enters his 17th year on the Bloomsburg sideline, racking up a 136-46-1 (.745) record. The 136 wins are first all-time in school history. For his career, Hale is 176-59-1 and his winning percentage of .747 is ranked among the top 10 active coaches in Division II. Hale has led BU to six playoff appearances, including the latest in 2008. He has been honored as the PSAC East Coach of the Year 10 times, the AFCA Regional Coach of the Year nine times, and was named the AFCA National Coach of the Year following the 2000 season.

Lee Owens (Bluffton '77) has a 35-20 record in his five seasons as Ashland's head coach. He has led the Eagles to NCAA playoff appearances in each of the last two seasons, putting together a 17-6 record over that span. Prior to Ashland, Owens was the head coach at the University of Akron from 1995-2003, compiling a 40-61 record.

**FOR OPENERS:** The Huskies are 30-41-1 all-time in season openers. However, more recently Bloomsburg has found early season success, going 5-1 in openers since 2003. The lone loss came at the hands of Division I-FCS opponent James Madison, 14-3, in Harrisonburg, Virginia. Danny Hale is 8-8 in season openers at Bloomsburg, including a 5-2 record in home openers.

**REDMAN AT NIGHT:** Tonight's game will be the very first night game at Redman Stadium. Lights were added prior to the 2008 season, however the latest start time for a game was 3:30 p.m. The Huskies will have another late start next week when they travel to California to play the Vulcans and will play host to the Marauders of Millersville on Saturday, October 3 at 5 p.m.

**IT'S A SMALL WORLD:** It might sound odd, but Hale shares something in common with Ashland Sr. QB Billy Cundiff: Both attended Green High School, just outside of Akron, Ohio. Hale was not at Green very long, attending his ninth grade year and playing football for the Bulldogs before his family moved to Marietta, Georgia. As a senior in 2004, Cundiff was second team All-Ohio and first team All-Suburban League. He led Green to three consecutive conference titles and three straight trips to the state playoffs. He attended Connecticut before transferring to Ashland in 2006.

## LAST MEETING

### Bloomsburg 49, Ashland 42 August 30, 2008

ASHLAND, OH--**Kenny Domzalski's** 23-yard scoring run with 54 seconds left lifted the 25th ranked Bloomsburg University Huskies to a 49-42, come-from-behind win over 15th ranked Ashland University on Saturday afternoon in the season opener for both teams.

Domzalski's touchdown capped a furious second half comeback for Bloomsburg which trailed 35-14 at the break.

Bloomsburg started the second half with a nine-play, 73-yard drive capped off by **Stefan Adams'** five yard scoring run to make it 35-21. After the Huskies defense forced an Ashland punt, Bloomsburg marched 54 yards in just six plays with quarterback **Dan Latorre** hitting **Kyle Ream** with 32-yard scoring pass to make it 35-28 with 6:13 left in the third period.

After an Ashland three and out, the Huskies quickly marched 68 yards in just three plays capped by Latorre hitting **Ben Weaber** with a 17-yard touchdown pass to tie the game at 35-all with 2:11 left in the third.

After a **Thomas McFarland** interception, Adams ran 31-yards for a score to give Bloomsburg its first lead of the game at 42-35.

Ashland tied the score with just 3:05 to play in the game with a 39-yard touchdown pass

After an Ashland penalty put the Huskies at the Eagles 39-yard line, fullback **Ryan Maggs** gained 16 yards on his first-ever carry, then Domzalski capped the comeback with his 23-yard run.

Ashland, though, still had time, but a pass as time expired fell short and the Huskies got the win.

Domzalski, in his first game, gained 172 yards on 16 carries with one TD. Fellow freshman **Derrick Price** gained 132 yards on 24 carries with one TD. Latorre finished 11 of 22 for 158 yards and three TD. Defensively, **Oscar Rivera** led the Huskies with eight tackles.

**SCOUTING ASHLAND:** The Eagles return nine starters from an offense that averaged nearly 35 points per game and over 440 yards in total offense. The triggerman is record-setting Sr. QB **Billy Cundiff**. Throwing for 3,776 yards and 37 TDs last year, Cundiff was the GLIAC player of the year and an AFCA first team All-American. Among his top targets will be two preseason All-American candidates in Sr. WR **Nick Bellanco** and Jr. WR **Joe Horn**. The two combined for 141 receptions for 2,166 yards and 18 TDs in '08. Cundiff will be joined in the backfield by Sr. RB **Dawon Harvey**, who led the conference in all-purpose yards per game (176.1) and was eighth in rushing (741), despite playing only eight games.

The defense will be led by Sr. LB **Marcus Council**, Ashland's leading returning tackler. Council will team with So. LB **Cory Skoczen**, who registered 61 tackles, 5.0 tackles-for-loss and three pass breakups last year.

The Eagles special teams will feature Harvey and So. RB **Carlin Isles** returning kicks. Isles averaged 21.0 yards on 25 kick returns in '08, including an 85-yard touchdown in the final minutes against Findlay. So. K **Gregg Berkshire** connected on 8-of-12 field goals, while Sr. P/QB **Derek Riedel** dropped 11 of 40 punts inside the 20-yardline last year, averaging 33.5 yards per punt.

**PSAC PRESEASON POLL:** The PSAC Preseason Coaches' Poll was released at PSAC media day on August 3 with Bloomsburg perched atop the Eastern Division. The Huskies received five first place votes, while last year's East champion, West Chester, was picked second. Out in the West, California, the 2008 PSAC Champion, was selected to defend its Western Division title. Here's a look at the rest of the voting:

**HUSKIES IN THE PLAYOFFS:** BU has made the NCAA Division II playoffs in three of the past four seasons and seven times overall. The Huskies claim a 7-7 overall playoff record, including a 5-2 mark games played at Redman Stadium. Last year BU faced two PSAC foes in second round opponent West Chester and California (PA) in the quarterfinals. Bloomsburg defeated the Golden Rams 28-21 before falling to the Vulcans, 27-24.

The Huskies also reached the NCAA playoffs after the 1985, 1996, 2000, 2001, 2005 and 2006 seasons. In 2000, Bloomsburg went 12-3 and advanced to the NCAA championship game, eventually losing to Delta State in the title contest. The team reached the finals after rallying from a 19-point deficit against UC-Davis in the national semi-finals to post a 58-48 win.

**BU VS. RANKED OPPONENTS:** Through the years, the Huskies have found success against other top schools in Division II, compiling a 26-34-1 record against ranked teams since 1985. That record has improved since 2000, as BU has gone 17-15, including a 10-5 mark against ranked opponents at Redman Stadium.

Among the 17 victories this decade are home wins against No. 5 IUP, No. 10 Northwood and No. 13 Millersville in 2000; No. 23 West Chester in 2005; No. 17 California in 2006; and No. 5 California in 2008. Away wins include No. 2 Cal-Davis and No. 11 Slippery Rock in 2000; No. 3 East Stroudsburg in 2005; No. 5 Shepherd in 2006; and No. 15 Ashland in 2008.

## Bloomsburg University Football Game Notes

**THE HUSKY OFFENSE:** QB **Dan Latorre**, now in his fourth year as the starter, graduated as a triple major in the spring and is now in grad school. One of the best players to ever wear a Husky uniform, Latorre, who was named first team All-PSAC East last year, heads into the 2009 season third all-time in school history in both yards passing and touchdowns and is the all-time leader in rushing yards by a quarterback. So. **Mike Wagner**, So. **Pat Carey**, a transfer from Lafayette, and R-Fr. **Clark Morris** will back him up.

So. TB **Derrick Price** burst onto the scene a year ago, leading the Huskies in rushing with a Bloomsburg freshman record 1,279 yards, while adding seven touchdowns on the ground. Price was named PSAC East Rookie of the Year in addition to garnering first team All-PSAC East honors. Fellow So. TB **Kenny Domzalski** also had a breakout freshman season, rushing for 878 yards, including 172 in his first collegiate game at Ashland. Domzalski went for 100 yards three times last year and earned a second team All-PSAC East selection. Sr. **Marc Best** and Sr. **James Sweeting**, who combined for 218 yards in a win over Cheyney last season, will provide depth.

Sr. **Stefan Adams** ran for 326 yards and 11 touchdowns last year from his fullback spot, while also catching seven balls for 27 yards. Adams scored two touchdowns in a game four times, earning second team All-PSAC honors. He will be backed up by So. **Matt Cox**.

The leading returning receiver from 2008 is Jr. TE **Ben Weaber**, who started seven of eight games last season. Weaber caught 11 balls for 114 yards and a touchdown in '08. So. **Dylan Manni** played in 11 games at tight end as a true freshman, adding two receptions for 25 yards. Sr. WR **Jordan Weisman** recorded nine receptions last year for 146 yards and one touchdown. Juniors **Cory Stiger** and **Chris Tressler**, along with sophomores **Tyler Guise**, **Keter Crosby** and **Brandon Wright** will all be battling for playing time at receiver.

The Husky offensive line lost some key pieces from last year and returns a young, but strong group that combined to play in 60 games, starting 25, last season. Jr. **Justin Walker** (13/13) leads the way and will pair with So. **Pat Casey** (11/0) at guard. Jr. **Matt Truscott** (12/2) and So. **Daryl**

**Kurtz** (13/11) will bookend the line at the tackle positions while Sr. **Tyler Azzalina** (5/0) will provide veteran leadership at the center spot. Sophomores **Alex Buchert** and **Michael Finnerty** and freshmen **Brian Clarke**, **Marc Francola** and **Courtney Kimp** will provide depth up front.

**THE HUSKY DEFENSE:** The defensive line will provide a rush from senior ends **Alphonso Nathan** and **Justin Presley**. Nathan started all 13 games a year ago, totaling 34 tackles with five tackles-for-loss. Presley played in all 13 games in 2008, recording 31 tackles, two fumble recoveries and four pass breakups. Sophomores **Dave Onorato** and **Josh Chromiak** will back them up.

A major push will come from the middle of the line as juniors **Todd Givler**, **Dave Huot** and **Marcus Zimmerman** will rotate at the tackle positions. Huot racked up 37 total tackles, including 8.5 tackles-for-loss and 2.5 sacks last season. Givler and Zimmerman combined for 41 tackles, six tackles-for-loss and three sacks in 2008. All three have starting experience. They will be backed up by So. **Kenny Orlando**, who played in 10 games last year.

Getting the nod at the outside linebacker positions are Jr. **Thomas McFarland** and Jr. **Michael Varanavage**. McFarland started 13 games last year, totaling 52 tackles, including five tackles-for-loss, two forced fumbles, a pass breakup and an interception. The interception, the first of his career, came in the season-opening come-from-behind victory over Ashland. Varanavage played in 13 games last year, starting two, and was fourth on the team with 53 total tackles. Extremely athletic, he averaged 7.3 points per game for the Huskies basketball team last winter. Sr. **Anthony Smith** looks to start at middle linebacker after playing in 12 games last season. R-Fr. **Jarrett Pidgeon** will back up Smith in the middle while R-Fr. **Ryan Feldman**, So. **Pat Michael** and R-Fr. **Sean Clift** provide depth on the outside.

The secondary is led by All-PSAC performer **Jesse Cooper**. The senior enters his fourth year as a starter, totaling eight interceptions, including three taken back for touchdowns, and 19 pass breakups in his career. Cooper, a preseason All-American, will be joined at cornerback by So. **Oscar Rivera**, who tallied 53 tackles and two interceptions last year. Fellow sophomores **Mark Scattene**, **Vince Browning** and **Andrew Fogel**, a converted quarterback, provide depth.

The safety spot also boasts returning starters in Sr. **Domenique Price** and Jr. **Alex Landis**. The duo combined for 85 tackles, two fumble recoveries, five pass breakups and two interceptions. Jr. **Dan Oliver**, who was in the safety rotation a year ago, emerged as a key contributor last year after transferring from LaSalle University. So. **Justin Rivera** will also see time.

**THE HUSKY SPECIALISTS:** Sr. **Jon Koenig**, a first team All-PSAC East kicker, returns as the Huskies place kicker and punter in 2009. Koenig has scored 203 points in his career, including 75 last season, second in the PSAC East. In addition to his kicking duties, Koenig punted 30 times for a 34.6-yard avg. In addition to being an All-PSAC defender, Jesse Cooper is also a standout return man. Cooper was second team All-PSAC as a returner last season, averaging 30.7 yards on 23 kickoff returns, with a 91-yard touchdown.

## Danny Hale

Bloomsburg University Head Coach



Danny Hale, one of the winningest coaches in all of Division II, will begin his 17th season at the helm of the Huskies in 2009. Hale also spent five years as head coach at West Chester University.

At Bloomsburg, Hale has posted a career record of 136-46-1 (.745) and holds the school record for most coaching victories. Overall in 21 years as a head coach he has a mark of 176-59-1 (.747) and is ranked among the top 10 active coaches in NCAA Division II in winning percentage. In his 16 seasons as head coach at Bloomsburg he has led the Huskies to 10 outright or shared Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Eastern

Division titles and six NCAA post-season playoff berths. In the period from 2000 to 2008 the Huskies are also one of the most successful NCAA Division II programs with a combined record of 84-22 (.792).

In 2008 the Huskies started the season winning the first nine games of the year, including wins over nationally-ranked Ashland and California (Pa). Bloomsburg earned a bid to the NCAA Division II playoffs for the sixth time overall, and fifth time this decade, reaching the NCAA Region One finals.

In 2006, the Huskies posted a mark of 12-2 and won the PSAC Eastern Division title, while also capturing the NCAA Northeast Regional title and advancing to the NCAA Division II national semi-finals. Hale was named the PSAC East Coach of the Year, the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Division II District I Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year award. By virtue of being a finalist for the award he was featured on an ABC-TV special hosted by Keith Jackson.

In 2005, Hale led the Huskies to a record of 11-1, including an unbeaten (11-0) mark in the regular season. It was just the fourth time in school history that a Bloomsburg team went through the regular season without a loss. He also earned PSAC Eastern Division Coach of the Year honors and the AFCA District One Coach of the Year award.

The Huskies have reached the NCAA playoffs in 1996, 2000 and 2001 seasons. During the 2000 season the Huskies were 12-3 and advanced to the NCAA championship game, eventually losing in the title contest. The team reached the finals after rallying from a 19-point deficit against UC-Davis in the national semi-finals to post a 58-48 win. Hale earned the American Football Coaches Association Division II National Coach of the Year following the season.

At West Chester Hale posted a mark of 40-13 and won three PSAC East titles and advanced to the NCAA playoffs in 1988.

Prior to West Chester, Hale was an offensive line and defensive coordinator at Colgate from 1981 to 1983. Prior to Colgate, Hale was the offensive line coach at Bucknell from 1975-80 and was defensive coordinator/linebacker coach at Vermont in 1974.

Hale is a graduate of West Chester, earning his bachelor's and master's degrees in Health and Physical Education in 1968 and 1973. He was an all-conference pick at West Chester and earned the team's most valuable player in the 1967 State Championship game, while also lettering three times for the track and field team. He is a member of the West Chester Football Hall of Fame and the Delaware County Chapter of the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame.

In 1968 Hale signed with the Pottstown Firebirds, the semi professional farm club of the Philadelphia Eagles, before entering the Marine Corps where he played middle linebacker for the Quantico Marines. Following a three-year stint, he was honorably discharged as a first lieutenant in 1972.
