### AT A GLANCE

BU travels to face PSAC West foes Gannon and Clarion this coming weekend. The Huskies have never defeated the Golden Knights in six tries, including last season's 82-45 loss to a squad that finished 26-5 overall. BU has had better luck against Clarion, posting a 12-11 all-time record. The Huskies have dropped two straight to the Golden Eagles, including last season's 80-71 loss.

### LAST TIME OUT

The Huskies went 2-0 in last weekend's PSAC cross-over matchups, defeating Lock Haven 70-38 on Saturday and Edinboro 65-59 on Sunday.

Against Lock Haven, the Huskies controlled much of the first half, leading by as many as 10 points. They opened their lead up even more with an early 13-4 run in the second half before taking the 33-point victory. Four players scored in double-figures for BU.

The Huskies found themselves down by as many as nine points in the first half to Edinboro before rallying for the six-point win. Sr. G **Ruben Britt** led BU with a career-high 30 points in the comeback.

## SENIOR LEADER

Sr. G **Ruben Britt** is 3rd on the Huskies in scoring (10.4 ppg) and rebounding (5.3 rpg) and tied for 1st in assists (26). He exploded for a career-high 30 points and 9 boards in BU's comeback win over Edinboro and has scored in double-figures in each of the past five games. During that span, Britt is averaging 14.6 ppg with a 59.6 FG% (31-52) in 31.2 mpg. He's also averaging 5.4 rpg with 16 assists and 9 steals over that stretch.

Britt led the Huskies in scoring with 13.2 ppg last season after transferring from Division I Coppin State. He also totaled 91 rebounds and 20 steals.

## IN THE MIDDLE

So. F **Larry Webster** has been dominant down low, averaging 6.4 rpg and a PSAC-leading 2.8 bpg so far this season. He has two double-doubles and has posted double-figure rebounds three times, including a season-high 13 against Lock Haven.

Against the Bald Eagles, Webster moved into BU's all-time top ten in career blocks, posting 5 during the game. After another 6 swats against Edinboro, he sits in 9th place with 62, just 5 behind Seth Scott (2001-04) who has 67 career blocks. Webster has 28 so far this season, including a BU single-game record 9 against Chestnut Hill.

Webster is 4th on the Huskies with 10.3 ppg, with six double-figure scoring games, and is 4th in the PSAC with a 60.8 FG% (48-79).

## HE SCORES...

So. G **Trevon Johnson** is the Huskies leading scorer, averaging 10.7 ppg and leading BU in points in three games. He had a break-out game against Wilmington, scoring a career-high 26 points in a comeback win. Since then he has scored in double-figures in five of seven games and is averaging 12.7 ppg with a 52.1 FG% (38-73).

## ...HE DEFENDS

Johnson has also been dominant on the defensive end of the floor, averaging 2.5 spg, good for 4th best in the PSAC. He has at least 1 steal in every game this year and has recorded at least 3 on six occasions, including a season-high 5 against PSU Hazleton.

## TOP FROSH

Fr. F **Ed Hall** has received two PSAC East Freshman of the Week awards this season, with the latest coming on Dec. 14 after averaging 12.7 ppg and 8.0 rpg in games against PSU Wilkes-Barre, Chestnut Hill and Pitt-Johnstown. His first came on Dec. 7.

Hall is 2nd on the Huskies in scoring (10.5 ppg) and 1st in rebounding (6.5 rpg). He has scored in double-figures seven times, including a season-high 17 against Pitt-Johnstown. Hall has started four times this year, including each of the past three games.

## OH CANADA!

Sr. G **Greg Elliott**, a tri-captain, has made six starts this season and is averaging 7.6 ppg and 2.1 rpg. He has scored at least 8 points in five games, including a season-high 19 points on 8-of-12 shooting

against PSU Wilkes-Barre. In his BU debut at Chestnut Hill, Elliott scored 9 points with 9 rebounds with 3 assists in 33 minutes.

Elliott sat out last season after coming to BU from Champlain College-St. Lambert in Montreal, Quebec, Canada. Averaging 12.0 points and 4.0 boards per game, he helped lead his team to two third place finishes at the CCAA National Championships.

### STEPPING UP

Fr. G **Jamar Smack** has started three straight games after coming off the bench in the previous seven. As a starter he is averaging 4.3 ppg and 2.7 apg in 22.7 mpg, adding 8 rebounds and 2 steals.

Smack had a season-high 11 points with 3 assists and 2 steals against PSU Wilkes-Barre and has hit 41.2 percent (7-17) of his 3's.

### OFF THE BENCH

So. G **Jesse Betar** has played well off the bench this season, appearing in nine games and averaging 19.7 mpg. He is averaging 4.8 ppg and 3.2 rpg and has collected at least 5 boards in four games.

Betar received more playing time in games against Lock Haven and Edinboro, averaging 6.5 ppg and 5.0 rpg with a 50.0 FG% (6-12) in 26.5 mpg.

So. G **Jordan Wartman** has also received playing time off the bench this year, appearing in seven games and averaging 9.4 mpg with 11 points, 11 rebounds and 7 assists.

### DOWN LOW

Jr. F **Earl Knight**, So. F **Trenton Epps** and Fr. F **Jesse Walsh** have provided a physical presence inside for the Huskies. Knight has appeared in all 10 games, starting six times, and is averaging 4.5 ppg and 3.4 rpg in 16.1 mpg. He has scored in double-figures twice and has grabbed at least 8 boards in a game twice.

Epps has also played in all 10 games, averaging 3.2 ppg and 4.2 rpg with a 48.3 FG% (14-29). Earlier this season Epps had a stretch of three games where he scored at least 5 points and grabbed at least 8 boards in each.

Walsh has seen action in six games this year, averaging 2.2 ppg and 2.8 rpg in 7.2 mpg. He had 5 points and 9 boards (4 offensive) against PSU-Wilkes-Barre.

### PLAYING "D"

The Huskies are 2nd in the PSAC and 17th in DII in scoring defense, allowing just 59.1 ppg. BU has given up 59 points or less six times, including 38 to Lock Haven and PSU Wilkes-Barre, the lowest total since St. Joseph's managed just 37 points against the Huskies during the 1994-95 season.

BU is 5th in the PSAC and 31st in the nation in blocked shots, averaging 4.5 per game, and 7th in steals with 8.3 per game.

### CRASHING THE BOARDS

The Huskies are 4th in the PSAC in rebounding margin, at +6.7 boards per game, with four Huskies average at least 4.2 rpg. As a team BU is averaging 41.0 rpg, good for 6th in the PSAC, grabbing at least 40 in six games.

Gannon has dropped three of its last four games after previously winning three of four. The Golden Knights are coming off back-to-back losses to Kutztown (75-59) and East Stroudsburg (75-54), but are 4-3 this season at home. They will be led by George Johnson, who scores 18.9 ppg and has a 43.1 FG% (44-102), 41.8 3FG% (23-55) and a 77.8 FT% (21-27).
