AT A GLANCE

BU returns to Nelson Field House to host West Chester in its PSAC East home opener. The Huskies own a 61-55 all-time mark against the Golden Rams, but have dropped the last four games in the series. BU's last win came during the 2006-07 season with a 75-69 victory in Bloomsburg.

LAST TIME OUT

The Huskies dropped their PSAC East opener on the road in Cheyney on Wednesday night, 73-52. It was the third straight loss for BU.

The game was tied at nine apiece before an 8-0 Cheyney run made the score 17-9 with 9:17 to play in the first half. After falling down by 13, the Huskies came back to cut the score to 30-21 before another run by the Wolves put them up by 16 at the half. In the second half, BU would manage to narrow the gap to 11 twice but Cheyney would close it out, ending the game on a 14-4 run.

Sr. G **Ruben Britt**, So. G **Trevon Johnson** and So. F **Larry Webster** all reached double-figures for the Huskies, scoring 10 points apiece.

SENIOR LEADER

Sr. G **Ruben Britt** leads the Huskies in scoring (11.0 ppg) and assists (35) and is 3rd in rebounding (5.2 rpg). He is also 2nd in steals with 18 and has an 80.0 FT% (24-30). He exploded for a career-high 30 points with 9 boards in BU's comeback win over Edinboro and has scored in double-figures in each of the past eight games. During that span, Britt is averaging 14.1 ppg with a 51.7 FG% (45-87) in 32.4 mpg. He's also averaging 5.4 rpg with 25 assists and 13 steals over that stretch.

Britt led the Huskies in scoring with 13.2 ppg last season after transferring from Division I Coppin State. He also totaled 91 rebounds and 20 steals.

IN THE MIDDLE

So. F **Larry Webster** has been dominant down low, averaging 6.1 rpg and is tied for 1st in the PSAC with 2.7 bpg so far this season. He has two double-doubles and has posted double-figure rebounds three times, including a season-high 13 against Lock Haven.

Against the Bald Eagles, Webster moved into BU's all-time top ten in career blocks. After posting another 13 in the last three games, Webster has moved into 8th place with 69. He sits 5 blocks behind Mike Day (1992-97) who had 74 for his career. Webster has 35 blocks so far this season, including a BU single-game record 9 against Chestnut Hill.

Webster is 3rd on the Huskies with 9.7 ppg, has eight double-figure scoring games, and is 3rd in the PSAC with a 59.4 FG% (57-96).

HE SCORES...

So. G **Trevon Johnson** is 2nd on the Huskies in scoring, averaging 10.8 ppg, and has led BU in scoring in five games. He had a break-out game against Wilmington, scoring a career-high 26 points in a comeback win. Since then he has scored in double-figures in seven of 10 games and is averaging 12.2 ppg with a 50.0 FG% (51-102).

...HE DEFENDS

Johnson has also been dominant on the defensive end of the floor, averaging 2.4 spg, good for 2nd best in the PSAC. He has at least 1 steal in 12 of 13 games this year and has recorded at least 3 on seven occasions, including a season-high 5 against PSU Hazleton.

TOP FROSH

Fr. F **Ed Hall** has received two PSAC East Freshman of the Week awards this season, with the latest coming on Dec. 14 after averaging 12.7 ppg and 8.0 rpg in games against PSU Wilkes-Barre, Chestnut Hill and Pitt-Johnstown. His first came on Dec. 7.

Hall is 4th on the Huskies in scoring (9.5 ppg) and 2nd in rebounding (5.7 rpg). He has scored in double-figures seven times, including a season-high 17 against Pitt-Johnstown. Hall has started five times this year, averaging 21.0 mpg in those contests.

OH CANADA!

Sr. G **Greg Elliott**, a tri-captain, has made six starts this season and

is averaging 6.2 ppg and 2.1 rpg. He has scored at least 8 points in five games, including a season-high 19 points on 8-12 shooting against PSU Wilkes-Barre. In his BU debut at Chestnut Hill, Elliott scored 9 points with 9 rebounds with 3 assists in 33 minutes.

Elliott sat out last season after coming to BU from Champlain College-St. Lambert in Montreal, Quebec, Canada. Averaging 12.0 points and 4.0 boards per game, he helped lead his team to two third place finishes at the CCAA National Championships.

STEPPING UP

Fr. G **Jamar Smack** has started four games and has played in all 13 this season. As a starter he is averaging 4.3 ppg and 2.3 apg in 21.0 mpg, adding 8 rebounds and 3 steals.

Smack had a season-high 11 points with 3 assists and 2 steals against PSU Wilkes-Barre and has an 81.3 FT% (13-16).

OFF THE BENCH

So. G **Jesse Betar** has played well off the bench this season, appearing in 12 games and averaging 22.6 mpg. He is averaging 5.8 ppg and 3.4 rpg and has collected at least 5 boards in five games.

Betar made his third start of the season against Cheyney and has received more playing time recently, averaging 8.0 ppg and 4.4 rpg in 29.4 mpg in his last five games. Against Clarion, Betar scored a season-high 15 points with 6 boards and played in a career-high 38 minutes against Cheyney.

So. G **Jordan Wartman** has also received playing time off the bench this year, appearing in 10 games and averaging 9.9 mpg with 17 points, 15 rebounds and 7 assists.

DOWN LOW

Jr. F **Earl Knight**, So. F **Trenton Epps** and Fr. F **Jesse Walsh** have provided a physical presence inside for the Huskies. Knight has appeared in all 13 games, starting six times, and is averaging 3.8 ppg

and 2.9 rpg in 14.3 mpg. He has scored in double-figures twice and has grabbed at least 8 boards in a game twice.

Epps has also played in all 13 games, including starts in each of the past two. In those contests against Clarion and Cheyney, Epps averaged 8.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg in 34.0 mpg and has an 85.7 FG% (6-7). Earlier this season, Epps had a stretch of three games where he scored at least 5 points and grabbed at least 8 boards in each. For the season Epps is averaging 3.6 ppg and 4.2 rpg with a 55.3 FG% (21-38).

Walsh has seen action in nine games this year, averaging 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg in 5.6 mpg. He had 5 points and 9 boards (4 offensive) against PSU-Wilkes-Barre.

PLAYING "D"

The Huskies are 1st in the PSAC and 26th in DII in scoring defense, allowing just 62.5 ppg. BU has given up 59 points or less six times, including 38 to Lock Haven and PSU Wilkes-Barre, the lowest total since St. Joseph's managed just 37 points against the Huskies during the 1994-95 season.

BU is 3rd in the PSAC and 25th in the nation in blocked shots, averaging 4.5 per game, and 7th in the conference in steals with 8.2 per game.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

The Huskies are 6th in the PSAC in rebounding margin, at +3.8 boards per game, with four Huskies averaging at least 4.2 rpg. As a team BU is averaging 38.8 rpg, good for 9th in the PSAC, grabbing at least 40 in six games.

Hegamin ranks in the top six in the PSAC in points (18.9 - 4th), rebounds (9.0 - 6th) and minutes played (35.1 - 4th). Roberts leads WCU with a 73.3 FT% (44-60) and is 8th in the PSAC with 26 steals.
