AT A GLANCE

The Huskies open up their 2009-10 PSAC East schedule as they travel to Cheyney to take on the Lady Wolves. BU owns a 34-11 all-time record over Cheyney, but has lost the last three in a row. In those games, the average margin of victory for the Lady Wolves was 2.7 points, including a 71-70 overtime decision at the Nelson Field House last year.

LAST TIME OUT

BU went 0-2 in last weekend's away PSAC cross-over matchups, losing to No. 4 Gannon 93-55 on Saturday and to Clarion 71-52 on Sunday.

The Huskies kept the game close against Gannon, trailing just 10-6 at the 12:37 mark of the first half. The Lady Knights would go on a shooting spree, however, taking a 40-25 lead into halftime before outscoring the Huskies in the second half. Fr. F **Kayla Oxenrider** scored 13 points with 3 steals in the loss.

Against Clarion, the Huskies quickly fell behind and trailed 25-8 with 6:35 left in the first half. BU would mount a comeback and trailed by just six points in the second half before Clarion made another run to seal the win. So. G **Kelsey Gallagher** scored 18 points, with 15 coming in the second half.

GREAT START

The Huskies 8-4 record is their best 12-game start to a season since 2001-02 when they went 11-1 to open the year. BU finished 21-6, advancing to the quarterfinals of the PSAC Tournament.

HUSKIES LEADER

So. G **Kelsey Gallagher**, one of two captains for the Huskies, leads the team in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and steals (24) and is 2nd in scoring (14.9 ppg). She also leads BU in minutes (34.2 mpg) and has a 41.5 FG% (59-142) and an 83.7 FT% (41-49).

Gallagher has a 33.3 3FG% (20-60) this season and her 80 career 3's puts her just seven behind Paige Hargrove (1992-96) for 10th all-time in BU history. Her 60 made 3's last year were the second most in a season behind Michelle Albanese's 67 in 2003-04.

Last year, Gallagher led the Huskies in scoring (15.4 ppg), assists (96), steals (60) and was second on the team in rebounds (5.0 rpg).

PSAC HONORS

Gallagher has earned two PSAC East Player of the Week awards so far this year, with the latest coming for period ending Jan. 3. She led BU to a 2-1 record in three games, averaging 20.7 ppg, 8.3 rpg, 2.0 apg and 2.0 spg. She scored a career-high 28 points in BU's loss to Goldey-Beacom but came back to total 34 points and 16 boards in wins over Lock Haven and Edinboro. She won her first award for period ending Dec. 6.

A preseason All-PSAC selection, she earned freshman of the week honors eight times last year in being named Freshman of the Year.

TOP FRESHMEN

Fr. G **Dana Wieller**, Fr. G **Alyssa Flanagan** and Fr. F **Lauren Biczelewski** have combined to win six of the eight conference freshman of the week awards this season, with Wieller taking four.

Wieller received her latest on Jan. 4 after averaging 17.0 ppg and 4.0 rpg in three games, also connecting on 9-23 3FG's and 10-14 FTs. Her other awards have come for periods ending Nov. 16, Nov. 22 and Dec. 13.

Flanagan earned her award on Dec. 7 after averaging 10.5 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 7.5 apg in wins over Wilmington and Concordia. Biczelewski got her award for period ending Dec. 22 after scoring 17 points in 17 minutes in BU's comeback victory over Philadelphia.

BIG TIME SCORER

Wieller, the top scorer on the Huskies, ranks 5th in the PSAC and 45th in the nation, averaging 17.4 ppg. She has hit double-figures in 10 of 12 games this season, scoring 20+ six times, including a season-high 29 against Nyack.

SHOOTING THE "3"

Wieller has found success from beyond the arc in her first season, connecting on 46.9 percent (46-98) of her 3-point attempts. She has knocked down at least 4 in eight games, including 7 against Penn State Schuylkill.

Her 46 3-pointers this season already puts her 8th in BU history in single season made 3's. Wieller's 3.8 made 3's per game ranks 1st in the PSAC and 6th in DII while her 46.9 3FG% is 2nd in the conference and 10th in the nation.

PLAYING THE POINT

Flanagan is 2nd in the PSAC and 20th in DII with 5.3 apg and is 5th in the conference with a 1.9 assist-turnover ratio (63-34). She recorded a season-high 9 assists and had just 1 turnover in her collegiate debut against Chestnut Hill and has at least 5 assists in eight of the Huskies 12 games.

The point guard is 5th on the team with 5.3 ppg, is 2nd with 23 steals and is shooting 40.0 percent (6-15) from 3-point range.

IN THE POST

Fr. F **Christine Sereta** has played well down low, leading BU in blocked shots (16), is 1st in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and has a 52.4 FG% (33-63). She recorded her first career double-double against Lock Haven with 16 points and 10 boards and has four games of double-figure rebounds this season.

Biczelewski has played in 11 games for the Huskies this year, averaging 6.4 mpg, 4.5 ppg and 1.9 rpg. In a three-game stretch against Concordia, PSU Schuylkill and Philadelphia, she averaged 12.3 mpg, 11.7 ppg and 3.7 rpg.

ALL-AROUND

Fr. F **Kayla Oxenrider** is an all-around threat for the Huskies, as

she is 3rd on the team in scoring (8.9 ppg), 3rd in rebounds (3.6 rpg) and 4th in assists (2.4 apg). She has started every game for BU, averaging 28.5 mpg and has 17 steals.

OFF THE BENCH

Fr. G **Tanejha Smith** leads all bench players in scoring with 4.6 ppg, and averages 11.5 mpg. She has posted double-figures in scoring three times, including a season-high 15 points against PSU Schuylkill and has a 34.4 FG% (21-61).

Fr. F **Lauren Ellis** averages 15.2 mpg and has two starts this season. She has scored at least 6 points in five games and had a 10-rebound game against Wilmington. She averages 4.2 ppg and 3.5 rpg and has a 45.7 FG% (21-46).

THE GRADUATE

Gr. G **Jen Dervarics** has played in 11 games off the bench this year, averaging 3.2 ppg and 2.9 apg in 15.8 mpg. She had a career-game against Penn State Schuylkill, notching a double-double with 11 points and 11 assists in 20 minutes off the bench.

Dervarics came to BU this year after four successful seasons on the soccer pitch at Bucknell University. A team captain and two-time Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year, Dervarics earned multiple honors and awards, including being named to the Patriot League Honor Roll three times.

TOUGH DEFENSE

BU's defense has been strong all year, forcing opponents to shoot just 36.0 percent from the floor, good for 4th in the PSAC. The Huskies also rank high in the conference in blocks (3.3 - 5th), turnovers forced (22.5 - 6th) and steals (11.1 - 6th).

The Huskies have recorded at least 10 steals in a game eight times this season, including 17 against Penn State Schuylkill. Six BU players have at least 10 steals and all 11 Huskies have at least 1.
