### AT A GLANCE

The Huskies look for two wins in a row when they host Mansfield on Wednesday at the Nelson Field House. BU owns a huge 45-8 all-time series lead over the Mountaineers, including winning last year's rematch, 75-63.

### LAST TIME OUT

Fr. G **Dana Wieller's** layup with 1.4 seconds left gave BU a 46-45 win over Kutztown on Saturday. The win snapped the Huskies two-game losing streak.

The Huskies started their comeback down by 45-33 with over five minutes remaining. Wieller scored 7 of BU's final 13 points, including the game-winner.

Wieller finished with a game-high 16 points while Fr. F **Kayla Oxenrider** added 13 points and Fr. F **Christine Sereta** had 14 rebounds.

### HUSKIES LEADER

So. G **Kelsey Gallagher**, one of two captains for the Huskies, leads the team in minutes (34.6 mpg) and is 2nd on the team in scoring (14.2 ppg), rebounding (5.8 rpg) and steals (38). She has a 39.9 FG% (83-208) and an 82.9 FT% (63-76). Her scoring average ranks 12th in the PSAC while her free throw percentage is 6th in the conference.

Last year, Gallagher led the Huskies in scoring (15.4 ppg), assists (96), steals (60) and was second on the team in rebounds (5.0 rpg).

## MAKING THE LIST

With her two 3's against Shippensburg, Gallagher moved into a tie with Paige Hargrove (1992-96) for 10th all-time in BU history with 87 made 3-pointers. For the season Gallagher has a 30.3 3FG% (27-89) and she is now just five 3's behind Christie Berry (1995-99) for 9th place. Her 60 made 3's last year were the second most in a season behind Michelle Albanese's 67 in 2003-04.

## PSAC HONORS

Gallagher has earned two PSAC East Player of the Week awards so far this year, with the latest coming for period ending Jan. 3. She led BU to a 2-1 record in three games, averaging 20.7 ppg, 8.3 rpg, 2.0 apg and 2.0 spg. She scored a career-high 28 points in BU's loss to Goldey-Beacom but came back to total 34 points and 16 boards in wins over Lock Haven and Edinboro. She won her first award for period ending Dec. 6.

A preseason All-PSAC selection, she earned freshman of the week honors eight times last year in being named Freshman of the Year.

## DOUBLE-FIGURES

Gallagher has reached double-figures in scoring 36 times during her short career, including 13 this season. She has scored at least 20 points 10 times during her career, with four coming this year, including a career-high 28 points against Goldey-Beacom.

## TOP FRESHMEN

Fr. G **Dana Wieller**, Fr. G **Alyssa Flanagan** and Fr. F **Lauren Biczelewski** have combined to win eight of the 11 conference freshman of the week awards this season, with Wieller taking six.

Wieller received her latest on Feb. 1 after scoring 16 points and hitting the game-winning layup with 1.4 seconds left against Kutztown. Her other awards have come for periods ending Nov. 16, Nov. 22, Dec. 13, Jan. 4 and Jan. 18.

Flanagan earned her award on Dec. 7 after averaging 10.5 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 7.5 apg in wins over Wilmington and Concordia. Biczelewski got her award for period ending Dec. 22 after scoring 17 points in 17 minutes in BU's comeback victory over Philadelphia.

## BIG TIME SCORER

Wieller, the top scorer on the Huskies, ranks 5th in the PSAC averaging 16.9 ppg. She has hit double-figures in 14 of 17 games this season, scoring 20+ seven times, including a season-high 29 against Nyack.

## SHOOTING THE "3"

Wieller has found success from beyond the arc in her first season, connecting on 44.3 percent (58-131) of her 3-point attempts. She

has knocked down at least 4 in 10 games, including 7 against Penn State Schuylkill.

Her 58 3-pointers this season is 3rd in BU history in single season made 3's. Wieller's 3.4 made 3's per game ranks 1st in the PSAC and 7th in DII while her 44.3 3FG% is 5th in the conference and 18th in the nation.

As a team, BU has 139 made 3's so far this season, just 5 behind the single-season team record set when the 2005-06 squad finished with 144. The Huskies are averaging 7.7 3's per game this season, good for 2nd in the PSAC and 15th in the nation.

### PLAYING THE POINT

Flanagan is 4th in the PSAC in assists with 4.3 apg and with a 1.5 assist-turnover ratio (78-51). She recorded a season-high 9 assists and had just 1 turnover in her collegiate debut against Chestnut Hill and has at least 5 assists in eight of the Huskies 18 games. Flanagan has also come up huge defensively for BU, recording 25 steals in the last seven games, including 8 against East Stroudsburg.

The point guard leads the team and is tied for 10th in the PSAC with 44 steals, is 5th for BU with 5.0 ppg, and averages 30.7 mpg.

### ALL-AROUND

Fr. F **Kayla Oxenrider** is an all-around threat for the Huskies, ranking 3rd on the team in scoring (9.9 ppg), 3rd in rebounds (3.9 rpg) and is tied for 3rd in assists (4.1). She's scored in double-figures in six of the past nine games, and averages 12.0 ppg with an 81.5 FT% (22-27) against PSAC East foes.

Oxenrider helped lead a 12-point comeback against West Chester, scoring all 16 of her points in the second half rally, and scored a game-high 17 points against East Stroudsburg. She has started every game for BU, averaging 30.2 mpg with a 33.0 FG% (58-176) and has 30 steals.

### IN THE POST

Fr. F **Christine Sereta** has played well down low, leading BU and is 3rd in the PSAC in blocked shots (31), leads the Huskies in rebounds (6.4 rpg) and has a 51.1 FG% (45-88).

She recorded her first career double-double against Lock Haven with 16 points and 10 boards and has five games of double-figure rebounds, including 14 on Saturday against Kutztown. Sereta posted a season-high 6 blocks against West Chester and has six games of 3+ blocks this year.

Biczelewski has played in 16 games for the Huskies, averaging 5.9 mpg, 3.6 ppg and 1.7 rpg. In a three-game stretch against Concordia, PSU Schuylkill and Philadelphia, she averaged 12.3 mpg, 11.7 ppg and 3.7 rpg.

### OFF THE BENCH

Fr. F **Lauren Ellis** averages 14.7 mpg and has three starts this season. She has scored at least 6 points in six games and had a 10-rebound game against Wilmington. She averages 3.9 ppg and 3.7 rpg and has a 44.1 FG% (30-68).

Fr. G **Tanejha Smith** is tops among bench players in scoring with 4.1 ppg, and averages 10.7 mpg. She has posted double-figures in scoring four times, including a team-leading 11 points against Shippensburg and a season-high 15 points against PSU Schuylkill.

### THE GRADUATE

Gr. G **Jen Dervarics** has played in 17 games this year, earning her first start against Shippensburg, averaging 2.8 ppg and 2.4 apg in 16.8 mpg. Against the Lady Raiders she had 5 points, 5 rebounds, 5 steals and 4 assists in a season-high 38 minutes. Dervarics has recorded 28 steals, picking off at least 3 in a game six times this year. She had a career-game against Penn State Schuylkill, notching a double-double with 11 points and 11 assists in 20 minutes off the bench.

Dervarics came to BU this year after four successful seasons on the soccer pitch at Bucknell University. A team captain and two-time Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year, Dervarics earned multiple honors and awards, including being named to the Patriot League Honor Roll three times.

### TOUGH DEFENSE

BU's defense has been strong all year, forcing opponents to shoot just 36.3 percent from the floor, good for 3rd in the PSAC and 45th in DII. The Huskies also rank high in the conference in turnovers forced (23.2 - 4th), steals (12.2 - 6th) and blocks (3.5 - 6th).

The Huskies have recorded at least 10 steals in a game 14 times this season, including 19 against East Stroudsburg. BU has hit double-figures in steals each of the past eight games and is averaging 13.8 spg. Seven BU players have at least 18 steals and all 11 Huskies have at least 1.

### SCOUTING THE MOUNTAINEERS

The Mountaineers have managed just three wins this year and have losing streaks of seven and six games. They're led on the court by Mallory Moore, who is tied for 6th in the PSAC in rebounding, is 4th with an 86.8 FT% (59-68) and 13th with 2.3 spg. Mallory Hafer has a 34.1 3FG% (46-135) and is 4th in the conference with 2.6 made 3's per game. The five starters get most of the playing time for the Mountaineers as each one averages more than 28.7 mpg.
