AT A GLANCE

BU looks for four wins in a row as it hosts Penn State-Schuylkill on Wednesday. This will be the first meeting between the two schools.

LAST TIME OUT

The Huskies shut down Concordia College 75-50 last Wednesday night in New York to improve to 4-1 on the season. Fr. G **Alyssa Flanagan** nearly recorded a triple-double, accounting for 15 points, 8 rebounds and 8 assists in the easy win.

BU started the game on a 28-4 run over the first 9:18 with three-pointers from Fr. G **Dana Wieller** and So. G **Kelsey Gallagher**. The Clippers fought back, outscoring the Huskies 16-11 to cut the lead to 39-20 at the half.

The Huskies would start the second half off strong, hitting more three-pointers to stretch their lead to 55-24 with 14:29 remaining, before finishing off Concordia with the 25-point win.

Flanagan shot 5-of-6 from the field, including 3-of-4 from three-point range, adding two steals and a block for the Huskies. Wieller connected on 4-of-7 three-point attempts, scoring 14 points and Fr. F **Christine Sereta** also scored 14 points for the Huskies.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

So. G **Kelsey Gallagher** was honored as the PSAC East Player of the Week for her play in wins over Wilmington (85-62) and Concordia (75-50).

She barely missed a double-double against Wilmington, recording 23 points and 9 boards to go with 5 assists, 5 steals and 2 blocks. Against Concordia, Gallagher scored 9 points and collected 3 rebounds, 5 assists and a steal in 25 minutes.

This is Gallagher's first career player of the week award. She earned freshman of the week honors eight times last season.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Helping to sweep the latest PSAC East women's basketball awards was Fr. G **Alyssa Flanagan**, earning Freshman of the Week honors.

Flanagan also came up big in each of the Huskies victories last week. She scored 6 points with 6 assists, 3 boards and a steal against Wilmington, and nearly recorded a triple-double against Concordia with 15 points, 8 rebounds and 8 assists. In 27 minutes, the point guard shot 5-of-6 from the floor, including 3-of-4 from behind the arc, and went 2-of-2 from the foul line, adding two steals and a block.

PRESEASON ALL-PSAC

Gallagher, a preseason All-PSAC selection, is second on the Huskies in scoring (14.2 ppg) and leads the team in rebounding (6.8 rpg) and steals (12).

Last year's PSAC East Freshman of the Year also leads BU in minutes (35.0 mpg), is third in assists (13) and shoots 49.0 percent (25-51) from the field and 88.2 percent (15-17) from the foul line.

Last year, Gallagher led the Huskies in scoring (15.4 ppg), assists (96), steals (60) and was second on the team in rebounds (5.0 rpg).

SHOOTING THE "3"

Fr. G **Dana Wieller** has found success from beyond the arc in her first season, connecting on 50.0 percent (22-44) of her three-point attempts. She has knocked down at least four in each of the Huskies five games this season.

So far in 2009, Wieller has been named PSAC East Freshman of the Week twice and is fourth in the conference in scoring with 20.4 ppg. She has reached the 20-point plateau three times this year, including a season-high 29 vs. Nyack on Nov. 11. She averaged 25.0 points per game at the Nyack Invitational, combining to go 15-of-34 from the field, including 9-of-17 from three-point range.

PLAYING THE POINT

Flanagan leads the PSAC with 6.0 apg and is eighth with a 1.8 assist-turnover ratio (30-17). She recorded a season-high 9 assists and had just 1 turnover in her collegiate debut against Chestnut Hill and has at least 5 assists in three other games.

The point guard is fourth on BU in scoring with 6.8 ppg, shoots 42.9 percent (9-21) from the field and has 7 steals on the season.

IN THE POST

Fr. F **Christine Sereta** has played well down low, leading BU in blocked shots (8) and field goal percentage (60.0 percent, 15-25) and is second in rebounding (6.4 rpg). Against Wilmington, Sereta had a team-high 11 boards and blocked 4 shots and scored 14 points on 7-of-9 shooting with 3 blocks against Concordia.

Sr. F **Giselle Lara** has also played well in the paint this season. She had a season-high 6 rebounds in just eight minutes against Concorida and had 4 boards (3 offensive) and 4 points in six minutes against Nyack.

DEFENSE

The Huskies have recorded at least 10 steals in a game three times this season, including 15 each against Chestnut Hill and Wilmington. Four BU players have at least 7 steals and 12 Huskies have at least 1. As a team, BU ranks eighth in the conference with 10.6 spg.

ALL-AROUND

Fr. G **Kayla Oxenrider** is an all-around threat for the Huskies, as she is third on the team in scoring with 10.2 ppg, fifth in rebounds with 3.6 and second in assists with 3.2. She has started each game for BU, averaging 30.0 mpg and has 8 steals.

OFF THE BENCH

In the Huskies first five games of the season, they have used as many as eight players off the bench who have combined to average 19.0 ppg. Fr. F **Lauren Ellis** leads all bench players in scoring with 6.4 ppg while ranking third on the team in rebounding with 4.4 rpg. She averages 17.2 mpg, has 9 steals and is shooting 53.8 percent (14-26) from the floor.

Fr. G **Tanejha Smith** is scoring 4.4 ppg while averaging 12.2 mpg off the bench for BU and has hit on 36.4 percent (4-11) of her three-point attempts.

THE GRADUATE

Gr. G **Jen Dervarics** comes to Bloomsburg this year after four successful seasons on the soccer pitch at Bucknell University. A team captain and two-time Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year, Dervarics earned multiple honors and awards, including being named to the Patriot League Honor Roll three times.

Dervarics has earned playing time in four games this season, averaging 12.8 mpg and 2.8 ppg while adding 9 assists and 3 steals.

RANKIN AT THE LINE

Jr. G **Steph Rankin** has been very successful at the foul line during her career at BU, posting an 83.3 percentage last year and an 82.4 percentage in 2007-08. Rankin has twice gone 5-of-5 from the line in a single game, one time last year against Millersville and once two years ago against Kutztown. So far this season Rankin has hit 2-of-4 shots from the foul line.
