### AT A GLANCE

The Huskies will open up the newly remodeled Nelson Field House as they host Wilmington in tonight's home opener. BU will look for revenge after last season's 85-77 overtime loss to the Lady Wildcats. This will be head coach Bill Cleary's second game against his former team.

### LAST TIME OUT

BU went 1-1 during their weekend trip to the Nyack Invitational. The Huskies dropped their Friday night game 80-79 to Dominican College on a buzzer beater by Rachelle Sainten. Bloomsburg would come back from a 46-41 halftime deficit, going on a 14-4 run to start the second half. The Griffins would slowly battle back over the course of the half, going up 77-72 with 2:19 remaining. The Huskies would carry a 79-78 lead into the final eight seconds before the last second shot by Dominican.

The Huskies would play a back-and-forth game with Nyack on Saturday afternoon, outlasting the Warriors in overtime, 80-72. BU led 27-26 at the half and both teams poured on the scoring in the second half as they took a 66-66 game into overtime. The Huskies would then turn up the defensive pressure, outscoring Nyack 14-6 to take the win.

## FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK...AGAIN

For the second time this season, Fr. G **Dana Wieller** was named the PSAC East Freshman of the Week for her play at the Nyack Invitational. Against Dominican, Wieller scored 21 points in just 24 minutes. She shot 6-of-11 from the field, including 4-of-5 from three-point range. Against Nyack, Wieller continued her hot hand, connecting on 5-of-12 shots from behind the arc and scoring a game-high 29 points in the Huskies overtime win.

Wieller also received freshman of the week honors for her efforts against Chestnut Hill in the season's first week. Wieller scored 18 points on 7-of-14 shooting, including going 4-of-8 from three-point range playing just 21 minutes of action in the BU victory.

## PRESEASON ALL-PSAC

After earning the PSAC East Freshman of the Year award and garnering second team all-conference honors last year, So. G **Kelsey Gallagher** has been named to the preseason All-PSAC East team for the 2009-10 season. She currently leads the Huskies in rebounds (7.3 rpg) and steals (7) and is second in scoring (13.0 ppg).

Last year, Gallagher led the Huskies in scoring (15.4 ppg), assists (96), steals (60) and was second on the team in rebounds (5.0 rpg) in winning freshman of the week honors eight times.

## THE GRADUATE

Gr. G **Jen Dervarics** comes to Bloomsburg this year after four successful seasons on the soccer pitch at Bucknell University. A team captain and two-time Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year, Dervarics earned multiple honors and awards, including being named to the Patriot League Honor Roll three times.

Dervarics last played competitive basketball while at Emmaus High School, where she guided her team to a District IV title during her junior and senior seasons, led the team in steals and assists, and was named the school's Athlete of the Year as a senior.

## PLAYING THE POINT

Fr. G **Alyssa Flanagan** recorded a game-high 9 assists and had just 1 turnover in her collegiate debut against Chestnut Hill. In the Huskies first three games this season she has 16 assists and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.2. Dervarics added 4 assists in her in first game and is averaging 2.5 apg so far for the Huskies.

## IN THE POST

Fr. F **Christine Sereta** and Sr. F **Giselle Lara** have combined to hold down the post, as BU has allowed an average of just 18.0 ppg in the paint this season. Sereta is second on the team with 5.7 rpg and has 4 blocks while Lara recorded a season-high 4 rebounds against Nyack and has 2 steals while averaging 3.7 ppg.

### DEFENSE

The 15 steals against Chestnut Hill were the most by the Huskies since they stole 18 against Penn State-Hazleton during the 2007-08 season. Flanagan, Fr. G **Kayla Oxenrider** and Fr. G **Lauren Ellis** each posted 3 steals, while eight total Huskies had at least one.

After three games, BU has 28 steals, with Gallagher and Ellis leading the way with 7 and 6, respectively.

### RANKIN AT THE LINE

Jr. G **Steph Rankin** has been very successful at the foul line during her career at BU, posting an 83.3 percentage last year and an 82.4 percentage in 2007-08. Rankin has twice gone 5-of-5 from the line in a single game, one time last year against Millersville and once two years ago against Kutztown. So far this season Rankin has hit 2-of-4 shots from the foul line.

### OFF THE BENCH

In the Huskies first three games of the season, they have used as many as eight players off the bench who have combined to averaged 19.7 ppg. Fr. G **Tanejha Smith** scored 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting with 4 rebounds against Dominican and Ellis led all bench players against Chestnut Hill with 9 points on 4-of-6 shooting in 16 minutes. She also added 2 rebounds, 2 assists, 2 blocks and 3 steals.
