Nelson Field House

The Nelson Field House, located on Bloomsburg University's upper campus, serves as home for most of the university's indoor athletic events. The facility has all the necessary ingredients as it holds a 3,000-seat arena for all home basketball and wrestling events, an indoor track, two tennis courts, an Olympic-size swimming pool and two handball/racquetball courts. The building has classrooms and offices for use by the health/physical education and athletic staffs. Nelson Field House also houses the wrestling practice room, which is a fully padded area located on the second floor. A totally equipped Nautilus room adds to the strength and conditioning area of the program, and Nelson Field House also offers a training room staffed by two full-time athletic trainers and no less than 12 student assistants. Also located in the facility is an equipment manager who handles the needs of Bloomsburg's 18 varsity athletic teams.
