SETTING THE SCENE

Bloomsburg University will send three wrestlers to Omaha for the 2010 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships. Making return visits to the NCAA championships are Matt Moley (157) and Rick Schmelyun (165), while Nate Graham (174) is making his first trip to the national championships.

Matt Moley will be looking to become the first three-time Bloomsburg University All-American since Rick Bonomo (1985-87).

Moley earned his ticket to Omaha by winning the Eastern Wrestling League (EWL) title at 157 pounds, while Schmelyun finished third at 165 pounds with Graham earning a bid as a wild-card.

STUTZMAN ON THE HUSKIES

"I like where we are at. Matt and Ricky are closing out their careers as two of the all-time greats in Bloomsburg University history.

They both have tough draws, but it's the NCAA tourney and you expect that! As far as Graham is concerned I feel confident for him and I like where he sits.

BLOOMSBURG NCAA QUALIFIERS



Matt Moley • 157 lbs • Phoenixville, PA/Spring-Ford
Two-time All-American (8th in 2008/6th in 2009)

Moley earned his fourth trip to the NCAA championships by repeating as the EWL champion at 157 pounds...Moley posted three wins at the EWL championships, one by technical fall and two by major decision...Is 25-3 overall on the season with 5 wins by fall, 5 by technical fall and 9 by major decision... Has 122 career wins and is tied for third all-time at Bloomsburg...Needs five wins to tie and six to break school record...Has faced six ranked wrestlers during the season going 3-3...Ended the season on an 11-match winning streak...Has wrestled six opponents who are in the NCAA bracket (Hadley Harrison, Cyler Sanderson, Dan Gonsor, Kurt Kinser, Bryce Saddoris and Jarrett Hostetter) posting a mark of 5-3 in those matches....Wrestled at the NWCA All-Star Classic against then number-one Jordan Burroughs of Nebraska... Won the 157 pound weight class at the PSAC championships in impressive fashion. Moley pinned his way through the 67th annual Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Championships. In his three bouts Moley racked up three first-period pins and was named the tournament's Outstanding Wrestler...Moley earned EWL Wrestler of the Week honors twice during the season...Was named the PSAC Wrestler of the Week on Dec. 7.



Rick Schmelyun • 165 lbs • New Oxford, PA/Bermudian Springs

Schmelyun is making his second trip to the NCAA championships...Earned a ticket to the championships by taking third at the EWL championships...Posted a record of 28-7 on the season with 10 wins by fall, 5 by technical fall and 7 by major decision (79 percent of his victories..22 of 28...by pin, tech fall or major decision)...Finished the season winning 10 of his last 11 bouts...Had a four-match streak going into the EWL championships where he didn't allow his opponent to score any points winning 18-0; 16-0, 16-0 and by fall in 1:18...Finished second at the Southern Scuffle in late December. Among his four wins at the Scuffle was a victory over defending NCAA champion Jarrod King of Edinboro by major decision, 15-2...Was named the PSAC Wrestler of the Week on Jan. 5 after the Southern Scuffle...Has faced seven of the 33 wrestlers in the bracket and has a record of 4-5 in those matches (Rendons, King, Val-limont, Jones, Young, Reeder, Martin-John)...Schmelyun has a career record of 116-55 and is tied for seventh all-time in Bloomsburg history on the career wins list (tied with Ricky Bonomo)...His 39 career pins are third all-time in school history.



Nate Graham • 174 lbs • Selkirk, NY/Ravena

Graham is making his first trip to the NCAA championships after earning one of the wild-card berths... Graham finished second the EWL championships falling in the finals to Phil Moricone of Edinboro, 6-1... Set a career-high in wins with 27 and in pins with six...Won six of his final seven matches during the season...Repeated as the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) 174-pound champion...Has faced seven of the 33 wrestlers in the 174-pound weight class (Lewnes, Zeerip, Bennett, Riccio, Beets, Smith and Moricone) and has a record of 1-6 in those matches...Has wins by fall this season in 45 seconds, 1:07, 1:12 and 1:24...Took second at the Buffalo Open.

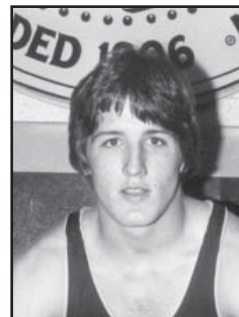

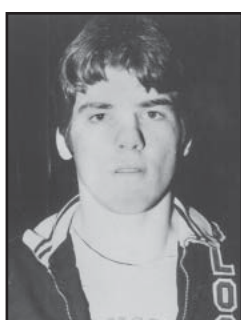
