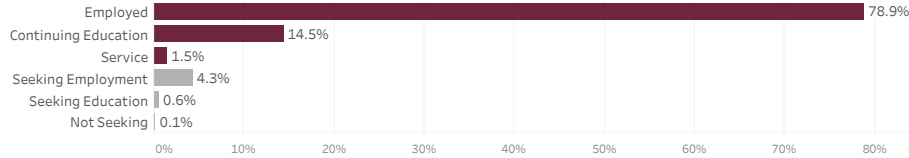

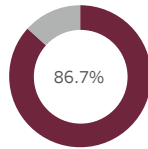
Primary Status After Graduation

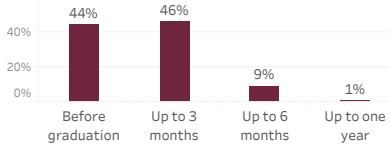

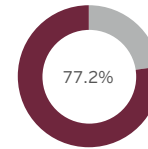
Employed Full-Time

Job Related to Degree



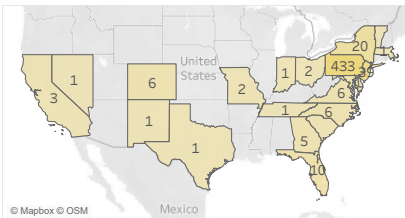
