Graduation Requirements: Students are required to have earned an overall 2.0 cumulative average to graduate. Accounting majors are required to have earned a 2.0 cumulative average in: 1) Business Core Requirements, 2) Accounting Specializations requirements, and 3) Electives in Business. Forty percent (40%) of all credits (48 credits) must be completed at the upper division level.
