COVID-19 Travel Guidelines 2021-22

As of March 1, 2021, the Order of the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Health for Mitigation Relating to Travel is no longer in effect. Therefore COVID-19 Travel Guidelines issued for the 2020-21 academic year have been rescinded. For your convenience, high-level recommendations and requirements for domestic (PA/Non-PA) and international travel are included below.

¹ While approval to travel internationally may be granted; it will be on a case-by-case basis based upon the <u>status of COVID-19 in the destination country</u>. It will require the traveler to consult with the appropriate vice president prior to submitting their Travel Approval Request. If approved to travel internationally, all safety protocols <u>for international travel during COVID-19</u>, as outlined by the CDC, must be followed.
