Instructions for Application for Non-Degree/Act 48 Admission to Graduate Studies

Applying for Admission

Mail the completed application with \$35 fee (non-refundable) to the School of Graduate Studies. Checks or money orders are payable to *Bloomsburg University*. The application should be in the mail at least six weeks prior to the requested date of admission in order to insure time for processing.

Non-degree/Act 48

Non-degree status is for students who do not plan to pursue a master's degree through Bloomsburg University or for students taking Act 48 credits. No more than twelve graduate credits taken in non-degree status will apply to a degree program. You are not eligible for financial aid or a graduate assistantship as a non-degree student.

Transcripts/Supporting Documents

Please request each college or university that you have attended to forward an <u>official</u> transcript. (Graduates of Bloomsburg University do not need to submit BU transcripts). These must be sent <u>directly from</u> the institution you attended (faxes not accepted). *Transcripts and all supporting documents should be sent to the Graduate Admissions, Bloomsburg University, 400 East Second Street, 161 A&A Building, Bloomsburg, PA 17815.*
