Faculty Scholarship Highlights

The zoom conversation was moderated by GBA coadvisor, Dr. Elaine Lau. Ms. Yang first shared her educational background and career path development. She then discussed the digital market characteristics in China and the business model her company applies. In her presentation, Ms. Yang emphasized the importance of having a global mindset as both a creative thinker and a doer. At the end of the presentation, the students interacted with Ms. Yang and asked her some questions. Students remarked that the presentation is very informative and the content is very up to date.
